



# Skirmish Paintball Club

**A**t Predator Paintball we have been asked many times **Is there a paintball club I can join?** Well, finally we can say yes!

We have developed a paintball club for people who have played social paintball games a number of times and are looking at regularly playing paintball on a larger scale and in a more competitive, yet friendly, environment with others who love the sport. The club will also avoid the hassle of getting 10 or more of your mates together to play paintball.

We have arguably the best bush & natural terrain fields in the Canberra region and we plan on holding club events as big bushball games with multiple objectives over large areas of our property, against one or more enemy teams.

Club members will also receive advice and assistance with buying and maintaining their own paintball gear, discounted paintballs on club days, and cheaper rates when playing with social groups on non-club days.

## **Games**

There will be at least 4 events held during 2010 with the date of each event set well in advance. More than 4 events may be held if there is sufficient interest. We will notify the date of each event by direct email and text messages to each member, on our website and with signs at the field.

Once an event date has been set and notified we expect each member to advise us of their attendance at least 2 weeks before the day. Members must also advise us if they intend to invite a non-member to the event. This will enable us to ensure staff and equipment is available for the day to run smoothly and so everyone has a great time.

Games will be held all over our property using current fields and other areas where social groups do not play. They will be strategic and demanding Big Games, against multiple enemies, accomplishing multiple objectives over a large terrain. Maps will be produced using Google Earth showing boundaries, starting points, objectives, re-spawn points, etc. A BBQ lunch will also be served at the end of the event.

This type of paintball is huge overseas with some events attracting thousands of players. Big games (also known as Bushball or Woodsball) are relatively new to Australia so we won't grow that large but we hope the games will be just as exciting and attract a good core of committed players. If there is sufficient interest from members we may also form a team(s) and travel to other paintball fields in NSW to play similar events.

## **General Rules**

- Ⓢ Players under the age of 16 years cannot play paintball in NSW and the ACT and therefore cannot be a member of the club;
- Ⓢ Players 16-17 years of age must have parental permission to join the club and parental permission to play each event;
- Ⓢ Players are not permitted to arrive at the field whilst under the influence of alcohol or drugs which may impair their judgement (both legal and illegal drugs);

## **Safety**

The club revolves around individual players respecting and abiding by our strict safety code. We expect that you, as a person who has played paintball a number of times before, can personally display a knowledge and understanding of our safety code and abide by it at all times.

People who have frequented Predator Paintball and have displayed unacceptable behaviour, including not playing the game in a sporting manner, will not be permitted to join the club. People that have displayed unacceptable behaviour at other paintball fields will also not be permitted to join the club.

Club members will have their membership cancelled immediately if their behaviour is unacceptable or cannot abide by our safety rules. Being accepted and remaining in the Skirmish Paintball Club is a privilege.

We want to promote the sport, not hinder it by having unruly individuals spoiling the enjoyment of others. We expect you to have a good attitude and be able to socially interact with other members that you may not know. If you want to be aggressive, cheat, challenge/question refs, complain, we suggest you find another pastime...

## **Membership**

To be accepted as a club member you must complete the application form and forward it to Predator Paintball along with a copy of your drivers licence or student identification. **Membership is free!** Once you have been accepted you will be sent a membership card which must be presented at all club events.

Acceptance to become a member is not automatic and the club is not obliged to approve anyone's membership. **People who have never played paintball before will not be accepted into the club** - play a few social games first so you understand what you're getting yourself into. The club will be operating under minimal supervision and therefore we expect you to understand and promote paintball safety rules. We also expect you to become self-sufficient on the fields such as being able to clean your gun, barrel, hopper and goggles and having the equipment to do so.

There will be a limit to the number of active members we will allow in the club, however, the limit has not been set at this stage. Club members must participate in at least 3 events per year.

Members may invite a non-member to participate in a club event with them. The

non-member must have played paintball a number of times previously.

## **Committee**

At this stage, the club does not have a committee made up of club members. As the club expands and matures we expect to handover the general club operations to an elected committee of members. Until that happens all decisions regarding the club will be made by the management and senior staff of Predator Paintball, in consultation with club members where possible.

## **Fees**

As a club member you will be entitled to great savings on gear and paintballs. Members who have their own gear and equipment are encouraged to use it provided it is legal and well maintained. There will be some gear on display for purchase at each event and we can order gear for you saving you freight and other potential discounts.
